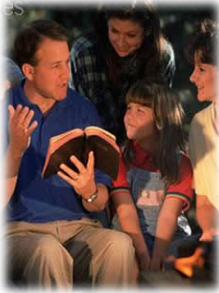


READ THE NEW TESTAMENT EPISTLES 2008
