I am so excited about Team Impact coming Wed.-Sun., Feb. 6-10. They will smash concrete blocks, and they will also deal the devil a body

blow as they share the gospel. Be sure to invite your friends and neighbors!

I never endorse candidates for office, but as your pastor, I have a moral responsibility to speak to social issues. Thus I encourage you to vote "no" on the liquor referendum Tuesday, February 5. Why?

1. Nowhere on the ballot does it mention a limitation on how much food must be sold in an establishment. A "yes" vote can open a Pandora's Box to bars.

2. Contrary to popular perception, we are not voting on restaurants! National chain restaurants require certain population and traffic counts to open a new franchise. If there is sufficient business, they will open without liquor. See www.affinghamfamily.org for a list of places where this has happened.

3. Increased liquor sales brings many social problems with it. Drunk driving accounts for 40% of traffic deaths in America. One in four violent crimes are committed by persons drinking alcohol.

4. Having lax liquor laws does not make Effingham County a better place to raise a family!

5. While drinking is not a sin, drunkenness is, and it is a sin to cause my brother to stumble (Romans 14:21). What message will we send to our children with this vote?

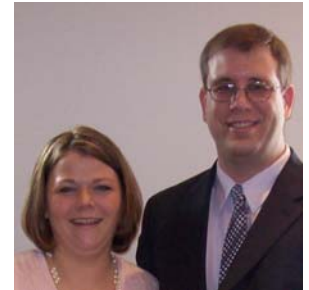
