On Wednesday, April 16, is Good Neighbor Night. On that night, church members will gather for pot-luck

meals in homes geographically spread all over the area (see the list on the front page of this newsletter). Let me encourage you to call the host nearest you, and ask what you can bring. It's a great way to get to know members in your area. And feel free to bring an unchurched friend, because it's also a non-threatening way for you to introduce people to our church.

This month two different teams from our church will leave on mission trips.

On April 9-16, I will be taking a group of four policemen to Colombes, France, in the suburbs of Paris. We will meet the mayor and policemen of Colombes and share our Christian faith with them. We are giving the policemen a Christian book for policemen, which Nathalie Knight has translated into French. We will also fellowship with the local Baptists, distribute Bibles, and share testimonies and preach at Centre Evangélique Protestant, which is the Baptist church in Colombes.

Then on April 27- May 3, Greg Hartzog, our Minister of Music and Senior Adults, is leading a group of senior adults to New Orleans, to participate in Operation N.O.A.H. (New Orleans Area Housing). They will be rebuilding homes damaged by Hurricane Katrina. Over 16,000 Southern Baptists have helped rebuild a thousand homes in New Orleans through Operation N.O.A.H., and it has opened many doors for the gospel in that city.

Please pray for both mission teams as we share *les bonnes nouvelles* (the good news) in France and in Louisiana.

See you Sunday with a Bible in your hand and the Risen Son shining on your face!

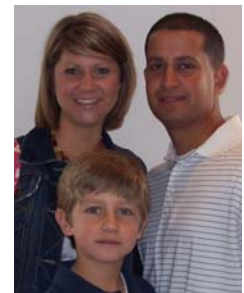
