on the kitchen table. So I went out to our magnolia tree, cut a flower from the tree, and put it in a vase filled with water. Within an hour, the flower had turned brown. That's when I learned that a magnolia flower will die if it does not remain attached to a living tree.

Jesus said, "I am the true vine; you are the branches. The one who remains in Me and I in him produces much fruit, because you can do nothing without me." (John 15:5, HCSB)

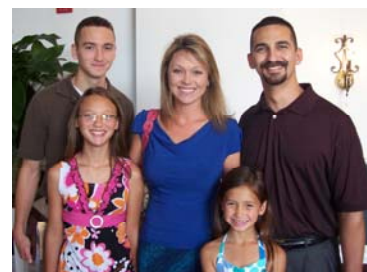
