October 9 is World Hunger Sunday. Please bring back the "bread box" coin banks with your spare change on that day, for the Southern Baptist World Hunger Fund. Right now there is a terrible hunger crisis in the Horn of Africa, and the need is great. You can also sponsor the RA's and GA's who are going on a walk for world hunger on Saturday, October 15.

The "Great Turkey Race" begins on Sunday, October 16. From then through mid-November, we will have a competition between Sunday School classes to bring nonperishable food items for Thanksgiving food baskets for local families in need. Then on Saturday, October 22, the youth group from Centre Evangelique Protestant (CEP), of Colombes, France arrives to spend eight days with us. The youth will be sharing testimonies and drama in worship on October 23, and joining us and our Hispanic mission for a special Lord's Supper in English, French and Spanish that evening, followed by a churchwide dessert fellowship in the chapel. During the week, they will visit many French classes and social studies classes in local schools, inviting students to a youth rally on Wednesday, October 26. They will also perform at the children's carnival on Friday, October 28. The team departs for France on the afternoon of Sunday, October 30. Pray for Pastor Thierry Auguste and the group as they prepare to come.

October ends with two big church events: the children's harvest carnival on Friday, October 28, and homecoming is on Sunday, October 30. You can read more about it on the front of this newsletter. I hope to see you there!

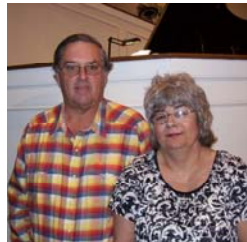
