See you Sunday with a Bible in your hand and the Risen Son shining on your face!

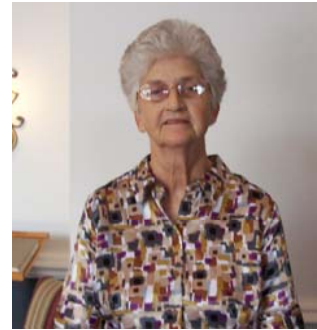

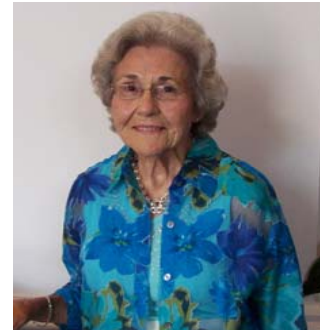

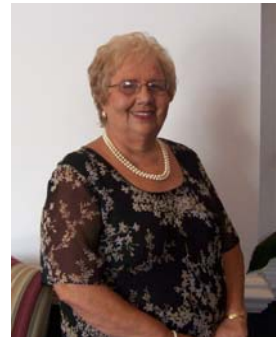
