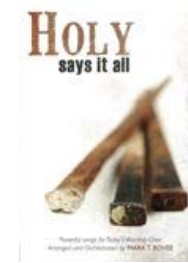

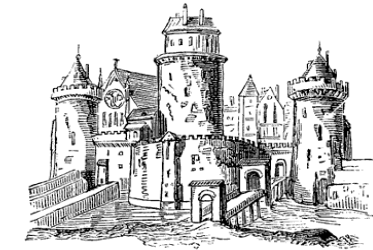

“Love Out Loud” was an amazing experience of shared ministry. We had 458 volunteers do 22 service projects, touching 1,700 lives for Christ, and presenting the gospel 786 times. Wow! We will definitely do this again.

March is the Annie Armstrong Season of Prayer for North American Missions. Southern Baptists have 5,300 missionaries in Canada and the United States, three out of four (255 million) of whom are lost without Christ. Our North American missionaries start new churches, do student evangelism, serve physical and spiritual needs of people through Baptist Centers in the cities, minister in resort settings, minister and share Christ in crisis pregnancy centers, provide training in apologetics (interfaith witness) and evangelism, etc.

When you give to the Acts 1:8 Missions offering, 25% goes to North American Missions. Our church goal for the Acts 1:8 Missions Offering for 2010 is \$45,000, so that means the North American Missions goal is \$11,250. I encourage you to pray for North American Missionaries, and give generously. All of the political statesmen, military geniuses and economic experts put together cannot save America, but Jesus Christ can!

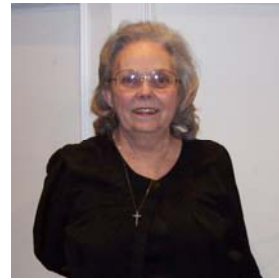
