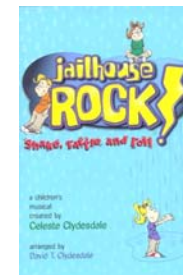

Last month, a judge in Wisconsin ruled the National Day of Prayer unconstitutional. The case is under appeal. No judge can forbid prayer or command prayer. Prayer must come from the heart. But if we do not plan to pray, and set aside times for prayer, we will pray less.
