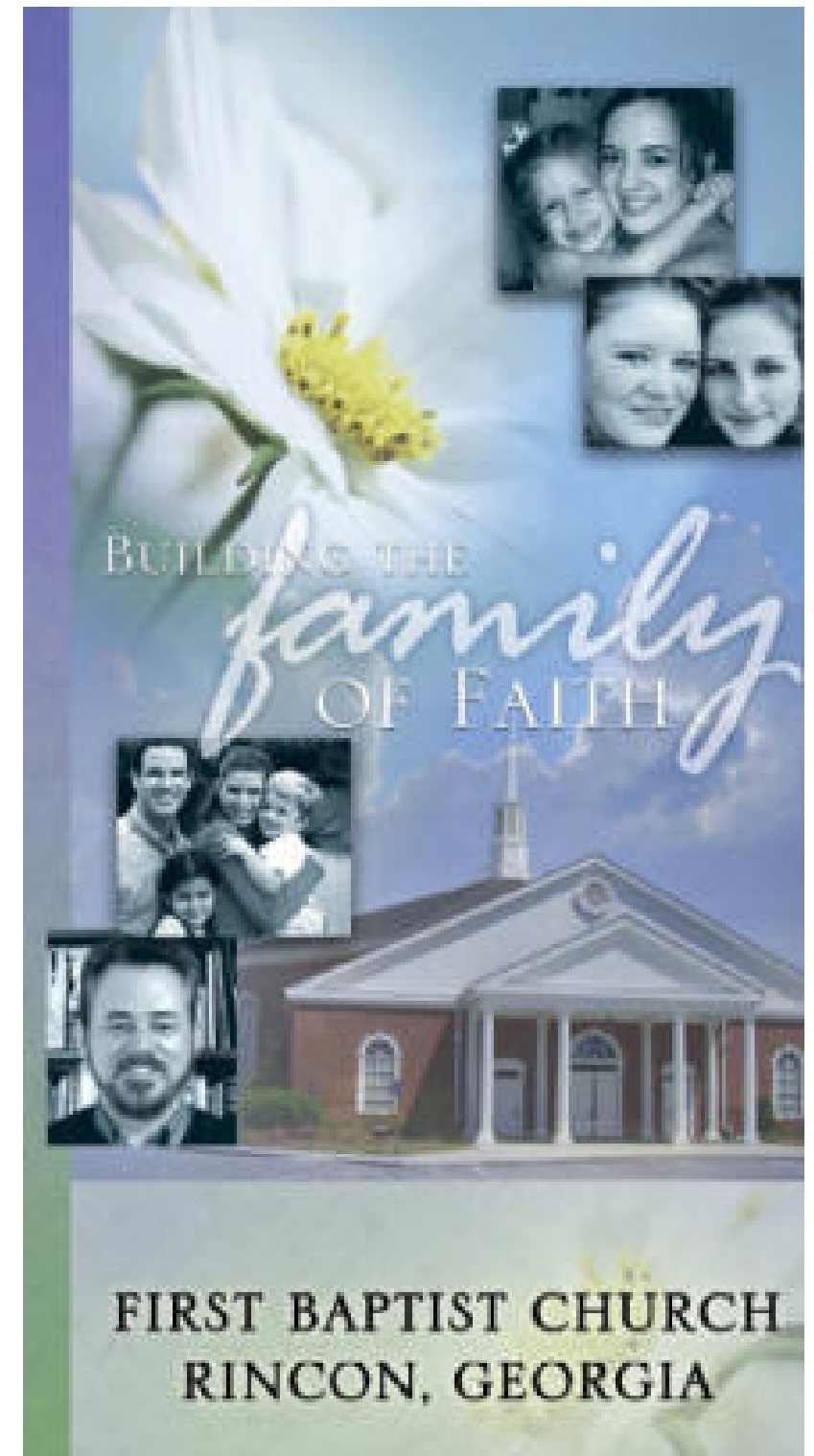

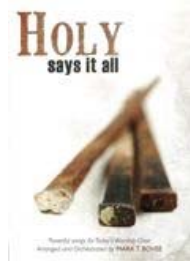
GUESTS: Welcome to First Baptist Church of Rincon! Please fill out a pink guest registration card (available in the hymnal racks) and place it in the offering plate.
