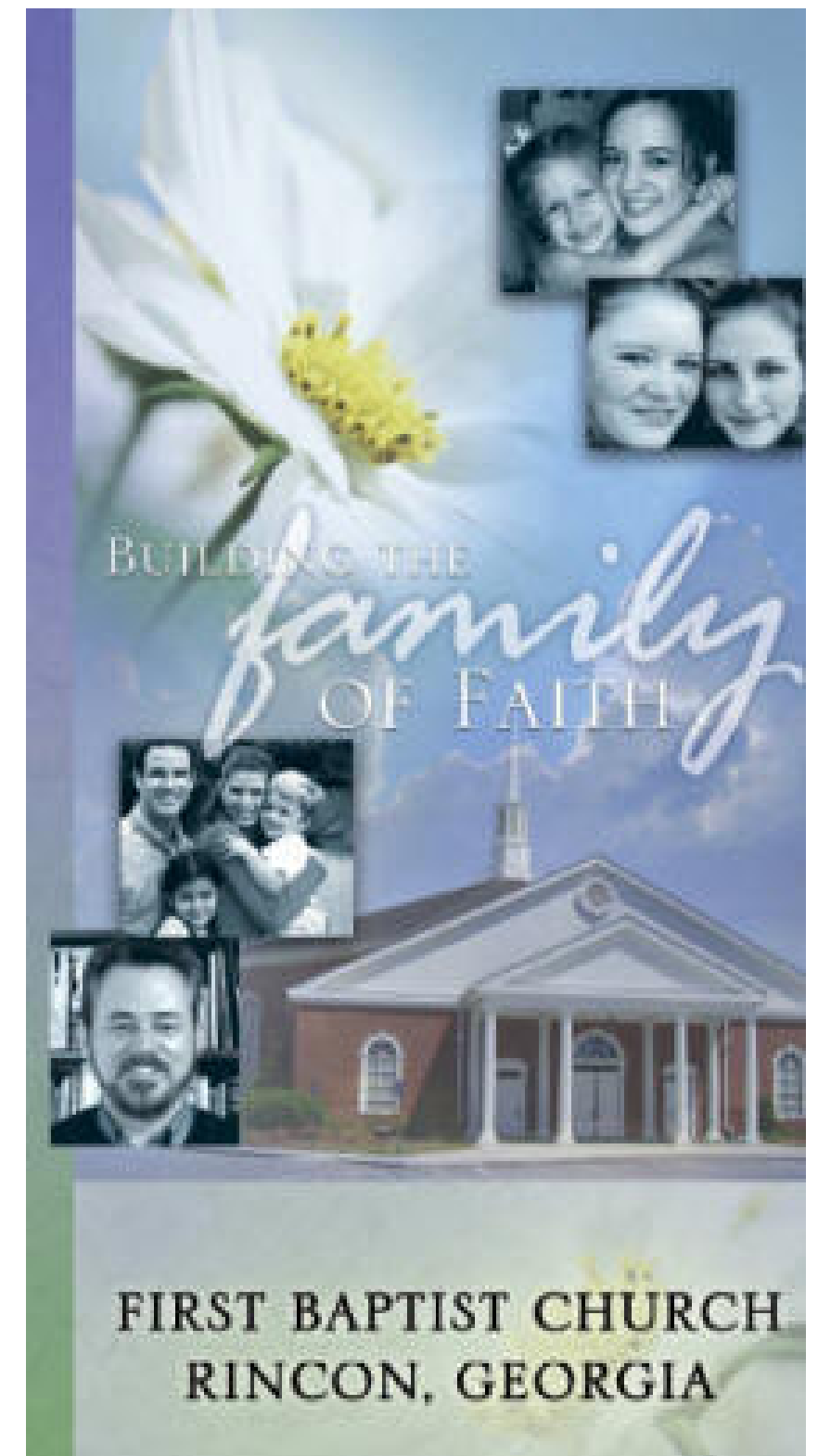

 10% to Georgia missions, and 10% to Savannah missions.



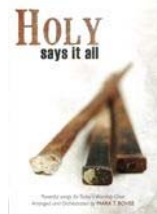
