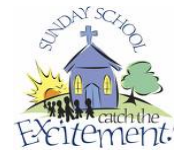

At the Savannah Baptist Assembly, 930 Honey Ridge Road, Guyton. If you need a ride, the bus will leave the church @ 3:45 pm.

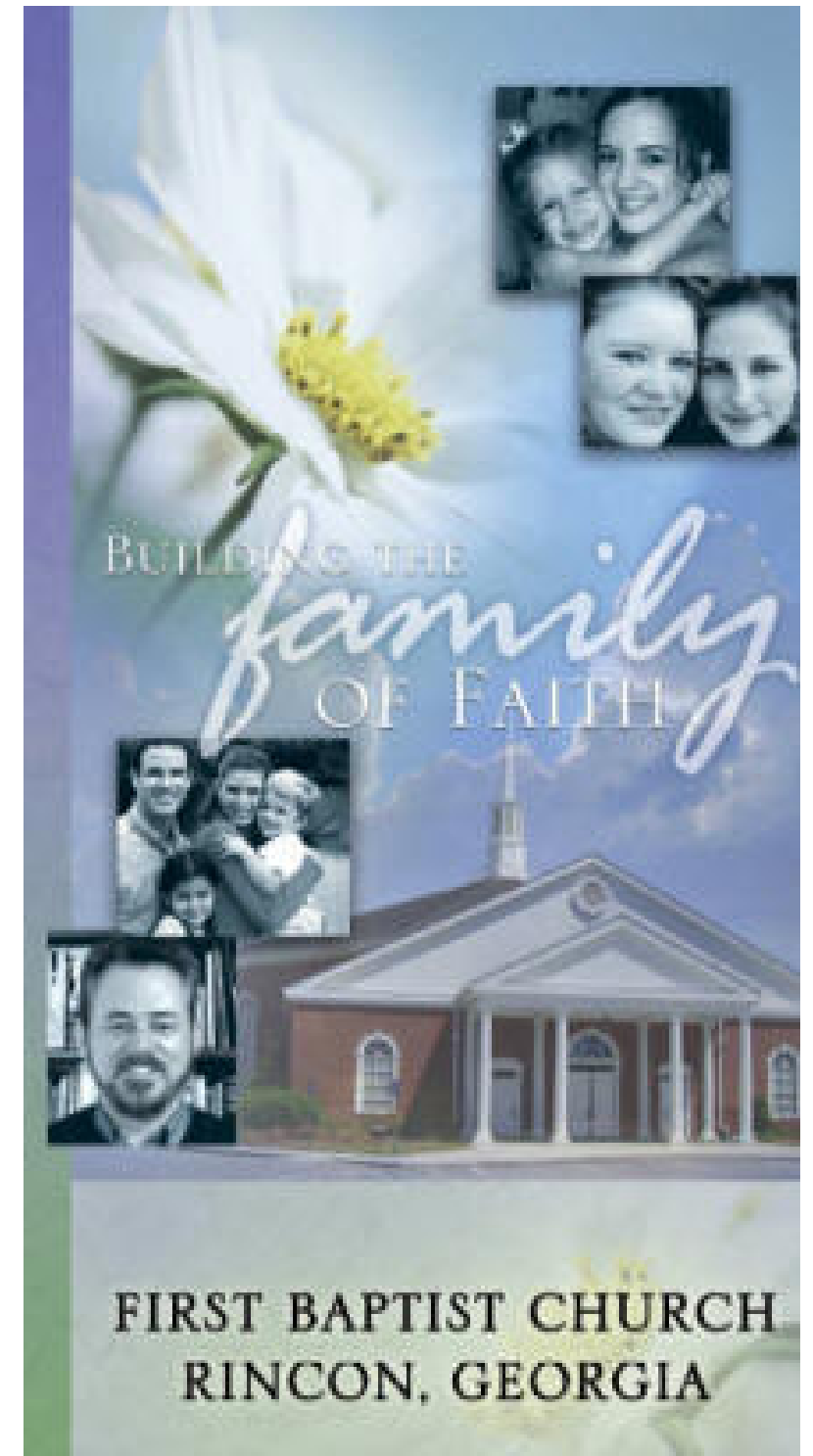
