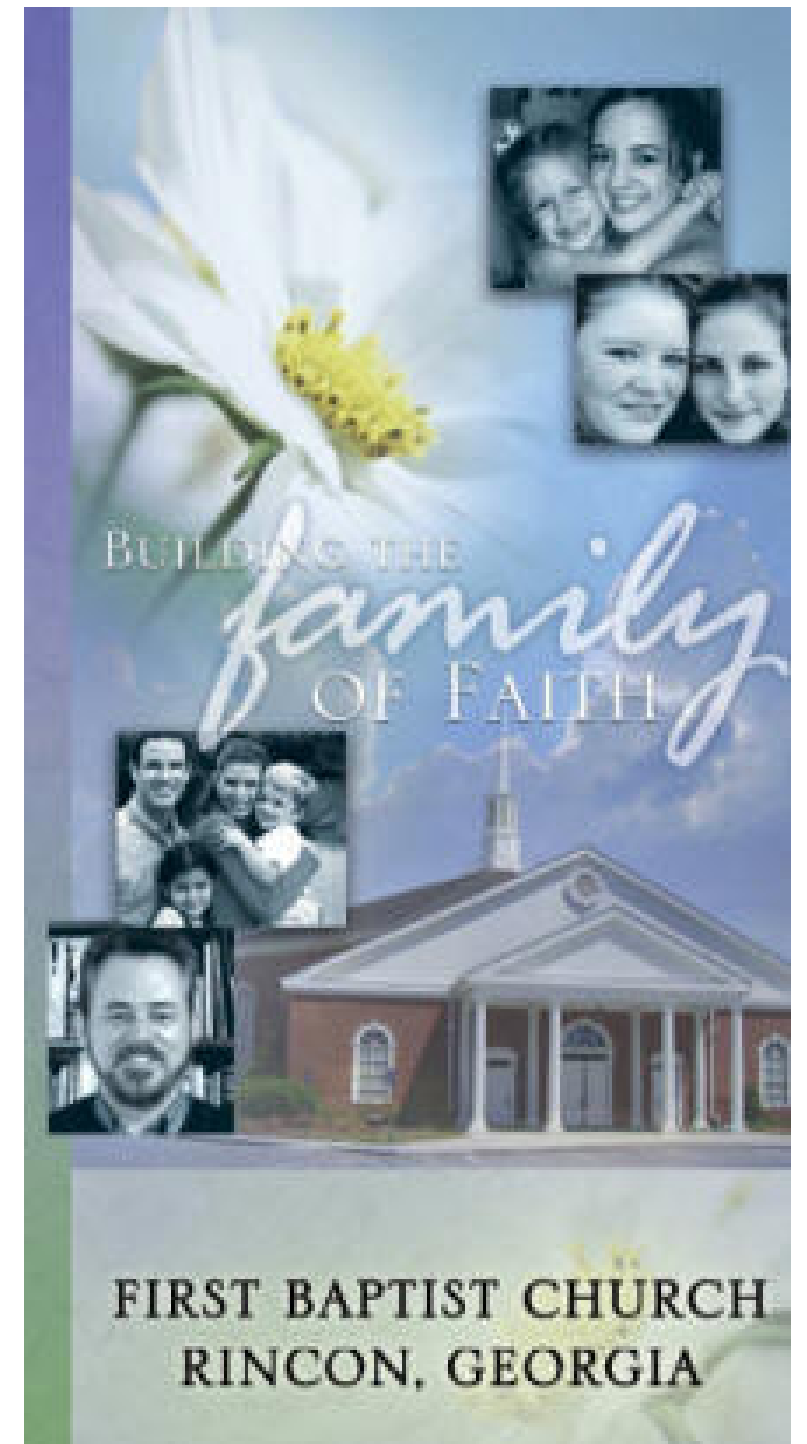
The bud vase is placed on the altar today in honor of Claire Elizabeth Davis, a girl, born to Sarah and Jonathan Davis.
