**Altar Flowers**

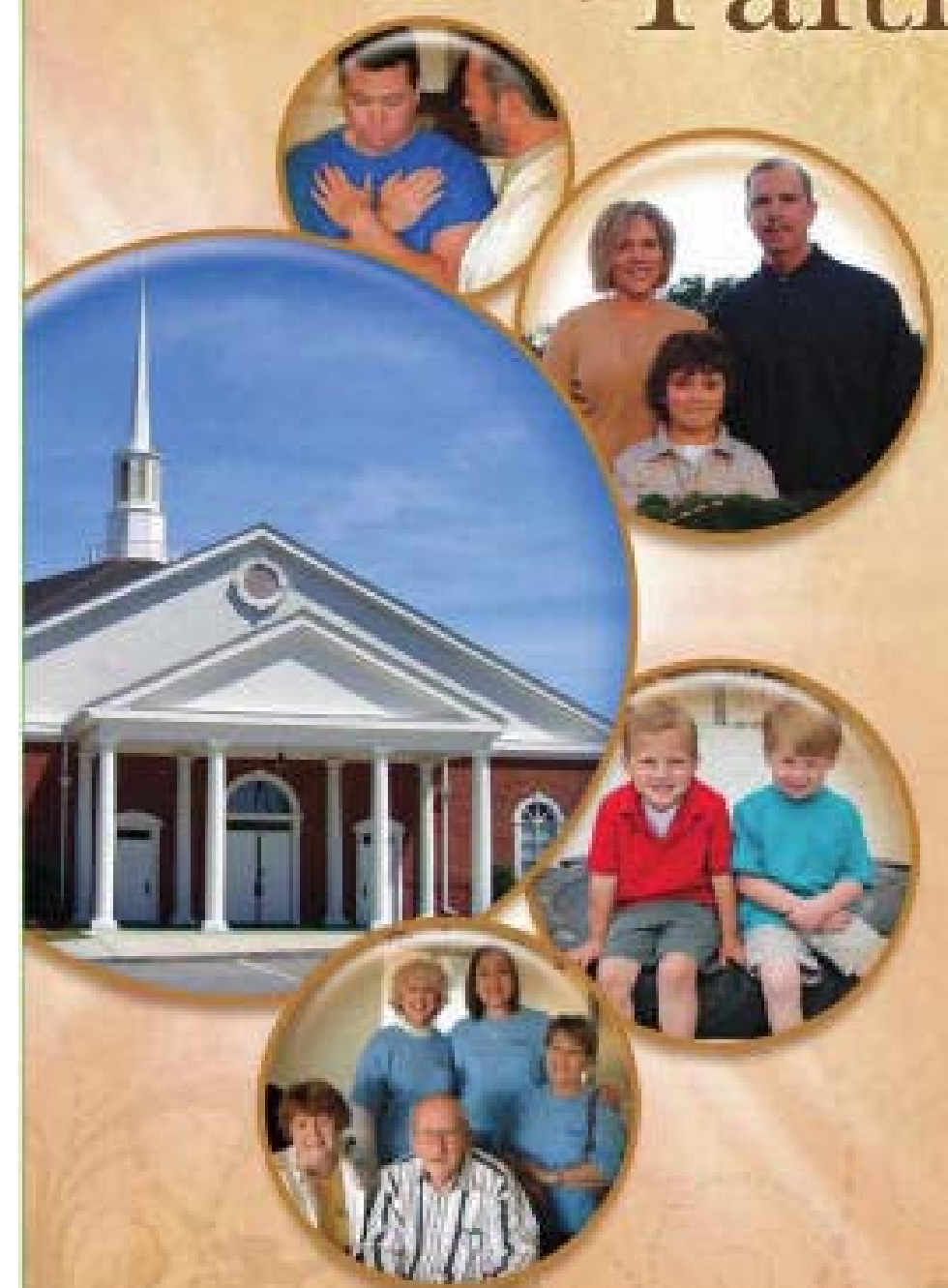
