My, how God has blessed with decisions for Christ in the recent evangelistic drama, *Last Chance*. Some have already made their decisions public, and

we are in the process of following up on many others. Thank you, church, for the wonderful way that you supported this effort. We had enough counselors to talk to all of those who came forward, even though we had 183 decisions in three nights. Of the 183 decisions, 72 were professions of faith! We sent references to 35 different churches, and we have over 60 decisions to follow up in our own church.

Each Sunday night after worship, we have volunteers who write cards and make phone calls to prospects (GROW teams), and other volunteers who make visits in homes (FAITH teams). We provide a light meal for our volunteers in the Memorial Chapel right after the evening service. If you can participate, let me or Bill Gammon know. We can train you in what to do, and if you go on a visit, we will put you with a leader who is already trained in how to share the gospel. "The harvest is abundant, but the workers are few. Therefore, pray to the Lord of the harvest to send out workers into His harvest" (Matthew 9:37-38, HCSB).

I am also pleased to report that after a summer of poor offerings, our offerings were over budget in August (see "Facts and Figures" on the next column.) We are still behind our budget goal for the year, so let's remain faithful, but this trend is very encouraging. Please remember also that if you wish to help pay for the new children's building, you need to give to Debt Retirement, not the Building Fund.
