







OUR HISTORY

In October of 1901, a small group of people gathered in the home of Mr. and Mrs. J.A. Wall to organize a Baptist Church in Rincon. Under the leadership of the Holy Spirit and Rev. J.M. Cross, the group constituted the First Baptist Church of Rincon, Georgia. In the early days of the church's existence, the church met in various homes in the community until a permanent 'meeting house' was purchased in July 1902. From the early 1900's, and continuing to the present, FBC Rincon has existed to love and serve all those who call Effingham county home as well as those peoples living without a consistent gospel witness around the world. These core commitments are further reflected in the vision and mission statements of the church.

FAMILY MINISTRY

KIDZ

Have kids? We've got you covered! We offer programs for kids birth-5th grade on Sunday mornings. Your children will be in a safe environment where they'll learn about Jesus while having fun and playing with friends! Once you arrive on our campus, head over to the Next Gen building to check-in your family before the service begins. Your kids will be with our trained volunteers where they will have a blast in our age appropriate environments!

PRE-SCHOOL (0-4yrs)

Our newborn-age 4 learn that God made them, He loves them, and wants to be their friend. Our facilities are clean and disinfected daily and all of our volunteers have been throughly evaluated to meet your kid's needs. Check-in at the front desk in our NextGen building and our volunteers will help you get your child settled in his/her class so you can attend our service.

ELEMENTARY (K5-5th)

We want our K5-5th kids to discover God's love for them and the fact that He has a plan for their lives. We use a rotation model so that our kids don't end up sitting in a classroom the whole entire time we have with them. Our kids gather on Sundays at 9:45AM & 11AM. Check-in at the front desk in our NextGen building and our volunteers will help your child get connected in his/her class so you can attend our service.

STUDENTS

The mission of FBC Rincon Students is to be a community for all 6th-12th grade students to discover and deepen a relationship with Jesus through community, worship, and engaging teaching that is relevant to all students. Whether you know Jesus, have doubts, or just have questions, there is a place for you at FBC Rincon Students.

SUNDAY MORNINGS

We provide Sunday School classes at 9:45AM for both middle and high school aged students to connect with friends, have fun, and engage with God's word through teaching and table talk discussions.

SUNDAY NIGHTS

In our Student Worship service on Sundays from 6PM-8PM we offer a mix of games, high energy worship from our student worship band, and engaging teaching from God's word, followed by discussion groups for middle and high school students.


